#### CLASS CHOICES FOR FRESHMAN STUDENTS

Required classes for Freshmen:

# 1. ENGLISH:

English 1

ESL – for non-English speaking students

# 2. HISTORY:

World Geography/Health-Drivers Ed

- 3. **FROSH PE** all students are required to take PE during the freshman year.
- 4. **MATH:** (level is based on 8<sup>th</sup> grade teacher recommendation)

Geometry (must have successfully completed the equivalent of high school Algebra)

#### 5. SCIENCE:

**Physical Science** (most students take this science. It is not college prep, but does count towards the physical science requirement for high school graduation)

Biology (college prep. This is a lab science. Usually this class is taken in the sophomore year. The only freshmen who should sign up are those students with good grades and excellent study habits)

### 6. ELECTIVE:

Freshman students will get 1 elective choice.

Language is not recommended until the sophomore year. Only a handful of freshman students should take language – these are students who have <u>excellent grades</u> and <u>excellent study habits</u> and can adapt well to high school.

Auto, Wood, Welding and Metal Fabrication, Ag 1, Beginning Foods, Drawing 1, Photo 1, Ceramics 1, Choir, Symphonic Band, Jazz Express (Zero period), Music Technology, Spanish 1

### 7. ZERO PERIOD CLASS:

If you sign up for Jazz Express, then you'll need to select 7 classes. A few select additional classes also may be available during zero period. If you plan to take a zero period class, you will need to provide your own transportation to school and sign up for 7 classes

Total classes: 6 (7 classes with zero period)

8. \*\*Must add 3 back-up elective choices in case your first choice is unavailable.
